

MINUTES July 6, 2020

The regular meeting of the Cumberland Township Board of Supervisors was held on July 6, 2020., at the Municipal Building but was closed to the public because of COVID 19. The meeting was called to order at 1:30 p.m. Supervisors present were James M. Sokol, William H. Nicholson, and Samuel H. Hastings. Other persons in attendance were Rebecca Bargerstock –zoning/code enforcement officer for Cumberland Township, and Debra Rush- Secretary/Treasurer for Cumberland Township.

There was no public in attendance so the meeting went to the agenda.

Motion was made by William H.Nicholson and seconded by James M. Sokol to accept the minutes from the June 1, 2020 meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by James M. Sokol and seconded by Samuel H.Hastings to accept the minutes from the continuation meeting held on June 22, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by William H.Nicholson and seconded by Samuel H.Hastings to pay all bills. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by James M.Sokol to pay all bills pertaining to the CDBG Program. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by James M. Sokol to award the bid to Big Dog Trucking , he was highest bidder for the 2009 Ford 550 truck the bid was \$ 6,122.00. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by James M.Sokol to approve to pay the increase of \$ 17,377.00 for the 2020 International Truck, this was for the Spreader and for miscellaneous changes to the body of the truck. The \$ 17, 377.00 came out of the New Machinery Fund. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by James M.Sokol and seconded by Samuel H. Hastings to update the Heavy Hauling Agreement between Cumberland Township and Chevron. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by Samuel H.Hastings to increase the Housing Rehabilitation deferred base grant from \$ 23,000 to \$ 24,500.00 and revise the program guidelines to reflect this increase; effective for contracts signed after July1, 2020. Motion carried unanimously.

Cumberland Township received \$ 706,932.95 dollars in Act 13 funds. A Resolution will be adopted at a later date designating what expenditures will come out of the Act 13 fund.

There was no new business.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by James M. Sokol to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting was adjourned at 1:50.
