The building was closed to the public because of COVID-19. The meeting was called to order at 4:00 p.m. Supervisors present were Samuel H. Hastings and William H. Nicholson. Other persons in attendance was Debra Rush , Secretary/Treasurer for Cumberland Township.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by Samuel H. Hastings to advertise for asphalt, oil, and pipe. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Samuel H. Hastings and seconded by William H. Nicholson to approve the revised ordinance regarding the storm water testing. The certificate is good for three years instead of one year. Motion carried unanimously. This will be Ordinance No 2-2021.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by Samuel H. Hastings to approve the ordinance regarding the contributions and the age for retirement in the nonuniform pension plan. Motion carried unanimously. This will be Ordinance No 3-2021.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by Samuel H. Hastings to approve a Resolution authorizing the contributions for the Police Pension Plan for the year 2021. Motion carried unanimously. This will be Resolution No 4-2021.

Motion was made by Samuel H. Hastings and seconded by William H. Nicholson to approve a Resolution urging PA's Independent Regulatory Review Commission to reject the proposed carbon dioxide budget trading program regulation as part of the Regional Greenhouse Gas Initiative. Motion carried unanimously. This will be Resolution No 5-2021.

Motion was made by Samuel H. Hastings and seconded by William H. Nicholson to approve the invoice in the amount of \$ 559.87 paid to Duane Wallace per year to maintain and post information on the website for Cumberland Township. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by Samuel H. Hastings to approve clean up days for Cumberland Township on Saturday April 24th and Sunday April 25th, 2021 from 7:00 a.m. till 3:00 p.m. No electronics, paints, liquids, household garbage will be accepted. Motion carried unanimously. The ad will be put in the paper.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by Samuel H. Hastings to hire Rob Toth as a part time probationary police officer for Cumberland Township with no benefits at a rate of \$ 15.72 an hour, after a year probationary period he will receive the rate of regular part-time police officer to agree with the Union Contract. Motion carried unanimously.
