Motion was made by Samuel H. Hastings and seconded by William H. Nicholson to hire Matt Wasinsky as summer help for Cumberland Township at a rate of \$ 10.00 an hour and no benefits. Motion carried unanimously. He will start on June 14,2021.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by Samuel H. Hastings to approve the contract with the County of Greene and Cumberland Township for CDBG FY-2020 CV Administration and execute said document for return to the County. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by William H. Nicholson and seconded by Samuel H. Hastings to award the contract for Project No. 20-044 Nesbit Road Twp-666 (AKA Nesmith) Road Repairs funded in part by the Dirt, Gravel, and Low Volume Road Maintenance Project by an Agreement between Greene County Conservation District and Cumberland Township to Jack's Excavating Inc, for \$ 38,048.79 contingent on approval of K2 Engineering and receipt of bonds and certifications. Motion approved unanimously.
